**HIGHLIGHTS FOR 2024 **

- 2024 marks the 43rd show of the Classic!
- The pre-registration for out-of-province participants will be online via assist expo again this year. See below for more information.
- Each team will be responsible for their own transportation to and from the RAWF.
- Two Chaperones per team are required in compliance with the guidelines of 4-H Canada, all
 county/regional/provincial teams at the 2024 TD Canadian 4-H Dairy Classic must have two (2)
 screened chaperones present during the show. Entrance passes/wristbands for two will be provided
 for entry into the show grounds as well as meal tickets. Any additional chaperones may make
 arrangements for entrance passes with the RAWF show office.
- All Chaperones will need to register via assist expo as well as participants. Entry deadline is October 15, 2024
- Trailer information must be provided prior to arrival at the RAWF.
- Hotels Teams are responsible for arranging their own accommodations. Richard Buck will have some blocks of rooms available. Please contact him directly to make arrangements. His contact information is:

- Clarification of Alternates & Herdsperson: A participant can be designated as an alternate and/or a
 herdsperson. If only registered as a herdsperson, they cannot step in as an alternate. This
 herdsperson must be registered with the TD Canadian 4-H Dairy Classic committee and must be a
 4-H dairy calf club member of the county that they have been registered with for the TD Canadian
 Dairy Classic. If registered as an alternate, they and their calf can participate in the competition,
 should one participant/calf be unable to attend. The alternate can also be registered as the
 herdsperson.
- Exhibits will be allowed 1 MOUNTED FAN per exhibit. No floor fans will be allowed.

Also Please Note:

- Entry fee is \$25 for all youth livestock exhibitors.
- To comply with ProAction requirements for Identification and Traceability, <u>all calves of all breeds</u>
 <u>must be tagged</u>-one tag pair in each ear with all four component parts identically numbered. All US animals must carry USDA tags with dairy breed sanctioned National tags.
- Only 1 (one) project per 4-H member may be pre-registered for the TD Canadian 4-H Dairy Classic.
- Team displays and animal move-in will begin at 6 am on Sunday, November 3rd. Veterinarians will be in place to perform the health inspections of calves.
- Showmanship Competition will be on Monday, November 4th; Conformation on Tuesday, November 5th.
- The Royal has eliminated the rule restricting a 4-H member from competing in only one Junior Livestock (Bovine) Show at the 2024 RAWF. However, move-in and move-out dates/times must be adhered to for both events, respectively.
- It will not be necessary to bring an animal's registration papers to the show; however, all project animals must be registered with their respective breed association and meet purity level requirements.

Pre-registration Guidelines

All Provinces (EXCLUDING Ontario):

- Every potential 4-H member (other than Ontario) that may be interested in competing in the 2024 TD Canadian 4-H Dairy Classic at the Royal Agricultural Winter Fair in November must complete PRE-REGISTRATION via assist expo by <u>June 1, 2024</u>. Click on the link: https://www.assistexpo.ca/rawf.
 - Quebec participants, please indicate which of the six designated regions you are from.
 - Only one (1) calf project per 4-H member may be pre-registered.

In Ontario

- Ontario 4-H Dairy members 12 years of age and over that register their project animal via assistexpo through 4-H Ontario by June 1st are considered pre-registered for the TD Classic. Please ensure that <u>all</u> information is included. https://www.assistexpo.ca/4-hontario
