






KAHNAWÀ:KE





Who are Cloverbuds?

Cloverbuds are members aged 6 to 8 years old, as of January 1st.

They are our youngest group of 4-Hers!

When did this happen?

This change was voted on at the Quebec 4-H AGM in November, 2024.

Why the change?

This change helps us to separate registered 4-H members from future 4-Hers who were also referred to as Pee Wees.

Reminder!

Future 4-Hers who are under the age of 6 years old are not old enough to be 4-H members yet.

They can participate in organized pee wee classes during 4-H activities, but are not able to participate in all club activities, and they require parental supervision at all times.
