Ormstown 4-H Runs the Ag Awareness Barn at Ormstown Fair

The Ormstown 4-H Club decided two years ago to put in a proposal to the fair board in Ormstown, to offer to organize the Ag Awareness Barn. It was an agreement in which the fair would pay an amount to the 4-H club and the club would provide animals for the petting zoo as well as educational content.

We had our first trial in 2023 and learned a lot, so we started planning during this winter for the fair that was held this past June. We lined up many different animals including water buffalo, pigs, goats, sheep, different dairy breeds and a few rare breeds. We made signs about the breeds and information about the different kinds of animals.

We also worked to fill the chicken barn with educational content since there were no birds again this year. We grew potatoes and cover crops in aquariums to show, we had samples of hay and straw, there were strawberries, seed samples and a worm farm. Each display had informative posters to go along.

And then we made sure to have 4-H members working in the animal barn all weekend to talk to visitors about farming and the animals. And there were 4-H members in the plant barn doing an activity with kids, teaching them what a plant needs to grow (soil, sun, water, air and space) – letting them plant a seed in a little container to take home.

All in all it's a great fundraiser for the club and a good opportunity for us to give back to the community and practice our public speaking skills while sharing our knowledge of agriculture with the public.
